GCSE Foundation maths resit — 30 weeks

Ordered by where the marks are for a learner sitting on grade 3, not by the order of the specification. Number and ratio come first and take twelve of the thirty weeks between them, because analysis of Edexcel Foundation papers from 2017 to 2024 puts them at roughly 60 per cent of the marks in the first ten questions of every paper.
